Physician engagement is pivotal for successful health care reform and many improvement initiatives related to quality, patient safety and value have been seen to rest on physician engagement. At Departmental Retreats held throughout the fall, KGH physicians and surgeons identified areas of strength and opportunities for improvement to enhance quality of care and their work environment. The process itself was seen as positive and a welcomed opportunity to connect with colleagues. What emerged as prioritized areas of focus for the KGHPS in the coming year was to

seek opportunities to enhance communication among and between various groups; to engage physicians in meaningful ways to influence care at KGH; to lead and participate in Continuous Quality Improvement initiatives; and, to explore opportunities to improve quality through enhanced use of technology.

Fully engaged & supported physicians with a meaningful voice in improving quality patient centred care, their working environment and the health system.



Did You Know:

- The Facility-Based Physician Engagement Initiative emerged from the 2014-2019 BC Physician Master Agreement.
- A Memorandum of Understanding signed by the Doctors of BC, the Ministry of Health and six Health Authorities guides this funded initiative.
- The KGH Physicians Society oversees this initiative at Kelowna General Hospital. It is governed by an elected Board of Directors and supported by a multi-departmental Working Group
- The Society was incorporated in September 2016.
- Annualized funding was approved in December 2016.
